SITE INSPECTIONS

I would like to thank South Derbyshire District Council [REP1-028] for suggesting locations for me to visit and points to note. This has helped me formulate the approach to site inspections for this Examination.

I note that most of the suggested locations are publicly accessible, and I therefore intend to view those locations on an unaccompanied basis.

I propose to seek access from relevant parties to the following locations that are not publicly accessible:

- private garden of Pennywort Cottage, Coton Road, Walton-on-Trent;
- Walton Hill Farm, Coton Road, Walton-on-Trent;
- · Fairfields Farm, Rosliston Road, Walton-on-Trent; and
- the proposed locations of the battery energy storage system and new 132/33kV onsite substation, Work Nos. 2 and 3 on the Works Plan [AS-003].

A member of the Planning Inspectorate's Case Team will join me at those locations. I will not have any discussion with any other parties present - their role will be solely to grant access, open any locked gates and direct me to the relevant part of the site.
